Dear parent / carer

The Science Department is organising a trip to Filey Brigg for Year 12 students to complete the Ecology element of their Biology course in the most engaging way possible.

The trip will give students the opportunity to perform random and systematic sampling of the environment and collect valid data. It will also allow students to develop sampling skills in the wild and apply theoretical ideas in a real environment. The data, once collected from the coastline, will be used to deliver the statistics element of the course when we return to school.

The trip will take place on **Thursday 26 June 2025**. We will depart from the Heads Lane site at approximately 8.30am in the school minibus and anticipate arriving back at Hessle High School at 3.00pm, traffic depending.

Students should wear sensible clothing suitable for all conditions, from stormy, windy, rainy to baking hot sunshine - waterproofs, sensible flat footwear (trainers, wellies, walking boots), hats (both sun hat and woolly/waterproof). They should also bring sunscreen and writing equipment with them. Students may take a packed lunch or enough money to purchase lunch from the food outlets on the promenade. **Please refrain from bringing along any nuts or nut containing products on the trip please due to potential allergies.**

To run this visit, we are requesting a contribution of **£5.00** per student which includes transport and insurance. If the contributions received do not cover the full cost of the trip, the trip may be cancelled and a refund given.

This is a voluntary contribution, however, please do not hesitate to contact us should you wish to discuss this further.
