Dear parent / carer

At the start of the academic year, students in Years 7-10 were informed of the possibility of reward trips taking place at the end of the year to reward them for developing our positive reward culture. This will help them embrace our core values as they meet targets to enjoy a fun day to celebrate the year.

To participate in these rewards trips, it will be necessary for students to complete the following criteria in three of the first four half terms and this must include:

- Autumn Term 1: September-October
- Autumn Term 2: November-December
- Spring Term 1: January-February
- Spring Term 2: March-April

Please note Spring Term 2 must be one of the half terms

The following criteria is required:

- At least 95% attendance
- Fewer than 15 negative behaviour points
- Fewer than 3 lates to school

If a student does not meet the above criteria due to a known medical condition or illness (medical evidence must be provided), Heads of Year may apply their discretion and still permit students to participate.

The Reward Trip criteria was launched to students in September and, since then, they have been tracking their own progress in passports that are used during morning tutor time. Using these passports have given students a visual idea of how they are doing weekly and adjusting/improving the following week.

We will be running individual trips for each Year group with all trips taking place in **July 2026**.

Information regarding the venues will follow shortly after the Easter break.
