Flash Cards

Why do we use Flash Cards?



- Work well for things you must memorise such as:
 - Definitions of keywords
 - Important dates
 - Equations
 - Names of equipment/parts of a diagram
 - Quotes
- A great way to summarise your work so that somebody can test you
- Easy to take with you when you go places
- Can be used as a question or as a prompt

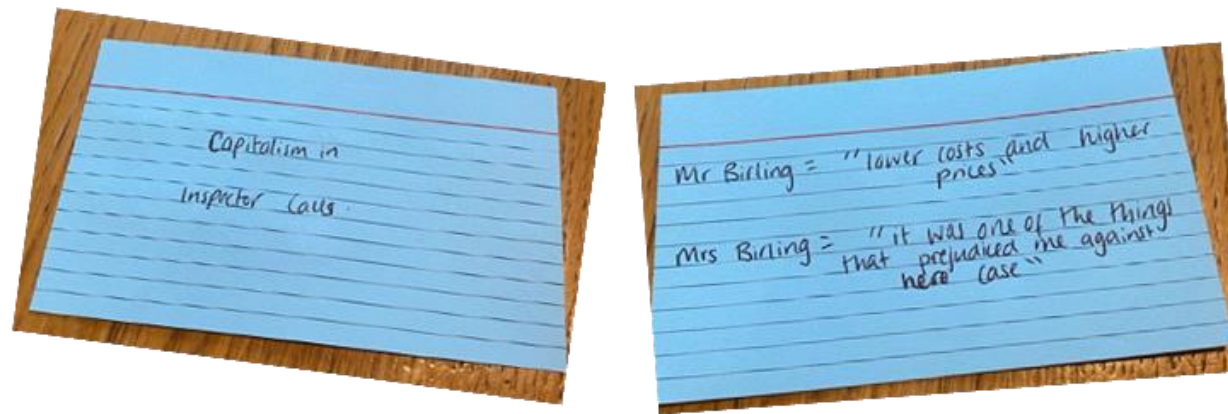
Side 2 – Answer
